

## Nomination

To study at the University of Siena as an exchange student, your home university must have an institutional agreement with UNISI. If selected, your university must nominate you must nominate you through the UNISI nomination form.

## Online Application Form

After nomination, you will receive an email with an access code to register in the Virtual Office (Segreteria Online) and start your online application.

Do not register before receiving the access code!

# Unisipass

During the application process students will receive by email their Unisipass: a username and a password that allows them to login into the Virtual Office (Segreteria online). Students must keep this password to have access to the UNISI digital services during their mobility period

## Application Deadlines


**June 30** → Admission for the 1st semester or full academic year

**November 30** → Admission for the 2nd semester

## Acceptance Letter

After submitting the online application students will receive an acceptance mail and practical information

Only non-EU students needing a visa will receive an official acceptance letter.



# Students must complete a Learning Agreement (study plan):

 As course information for the next academic year may not be available, use the current details.

Learning Agreement

- Choose courses from the UNISI Course Catalogue
- The learning agreement must be signed by the student, the responsible person at the sending university and the responsible person at the receiving institution (the University of Siena).
- The responsible person at the University of Siena for signing the learning agreement is the academic Erasmus/Exchange coordinator (USiena Exchange Coordinator)..

Non-European students or European students not enabled on the OLA platform must fill out the form available at this link and send it by email as a pdf document to the USiena Exchange Coordinator.

# Italian Language Courses

The University of Siena organizes Italian language courses for exchange students needing to improve their Italian language skills.

There are two kind of courses:

- Intensive language courses before the semester starts in the months of September and February
- Extensive language courses during the semester, in October and Novembre - 1st semester March and April -2nd semester
