APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Nomination	<p>Partner Universities must send the students' nominations through the Unisi Nomination Form. The Incoming Mobility Team will provide the partner Universities with the link to the nomination form.</p> <p>Nomination deadline:</p> <p>May 31st (for 1st semester students) October 31st (for 2nd semester students)</p>
Application Form	<p>Once the nomination has been checked and accepted, students will receive an access code and a web link to register with our Virtual Office (Segreteira online) and will then be able to enter and upload all required information to complete their application. Students do not have to register on "Segreteria online" before receiving the access code!</p> <p>After completing the application form, exchange students will receive an acceptance mail and practical information.</p> <p><i>Please note: The Incoming Mobility Team will only send acceptance letters to non EU students for visa arrangements.</i></p> <p>How to submit the online application form: https://en.unisi.it/international/international-exchange-students/prior-arrival</p>
Application Deadline	<p>June 30th (for first semester students) November 30th (for second semester students)</p>
Unisipass	<p>During the application process students will receive their Unisipass: a username and a password which allows them to login into the Virtual Office (Segreteria online).</p> <p>Students must keep the Unisipass to have access to the UNISI digital services during the mobility period.</p> <p>https://www.uet.unisi.it/credenziali-unisipass/</p>

Learning Agreement

Before the mobility

The learning agreement must be signed by the student, the responsible person at the sending university and the responsible person at the receiving institution (the University of Siena).

The responsible person at the University of Siena for signing the learning agreement is the academic Erasmus/Exchange coordinator

How to send the learning agreement to the USiena Exchange Coordinator?

- European students must fill out the learning agreement on the OLA platform (online learning agreement) and write the name and email address of the Unisi exchange coordinator on the section “Receiving Responsible Person”.
- Non-European students or European students not enabled on the OLA platform must fill out the Learning Agreement template available at this link and send it by email as a pdf document to the USiena Exchange Coordinator.

Deadlines:

- From July 1st to September 15th (for first semester students)
- From December 1st 2025 to February 15th (for second semester students)

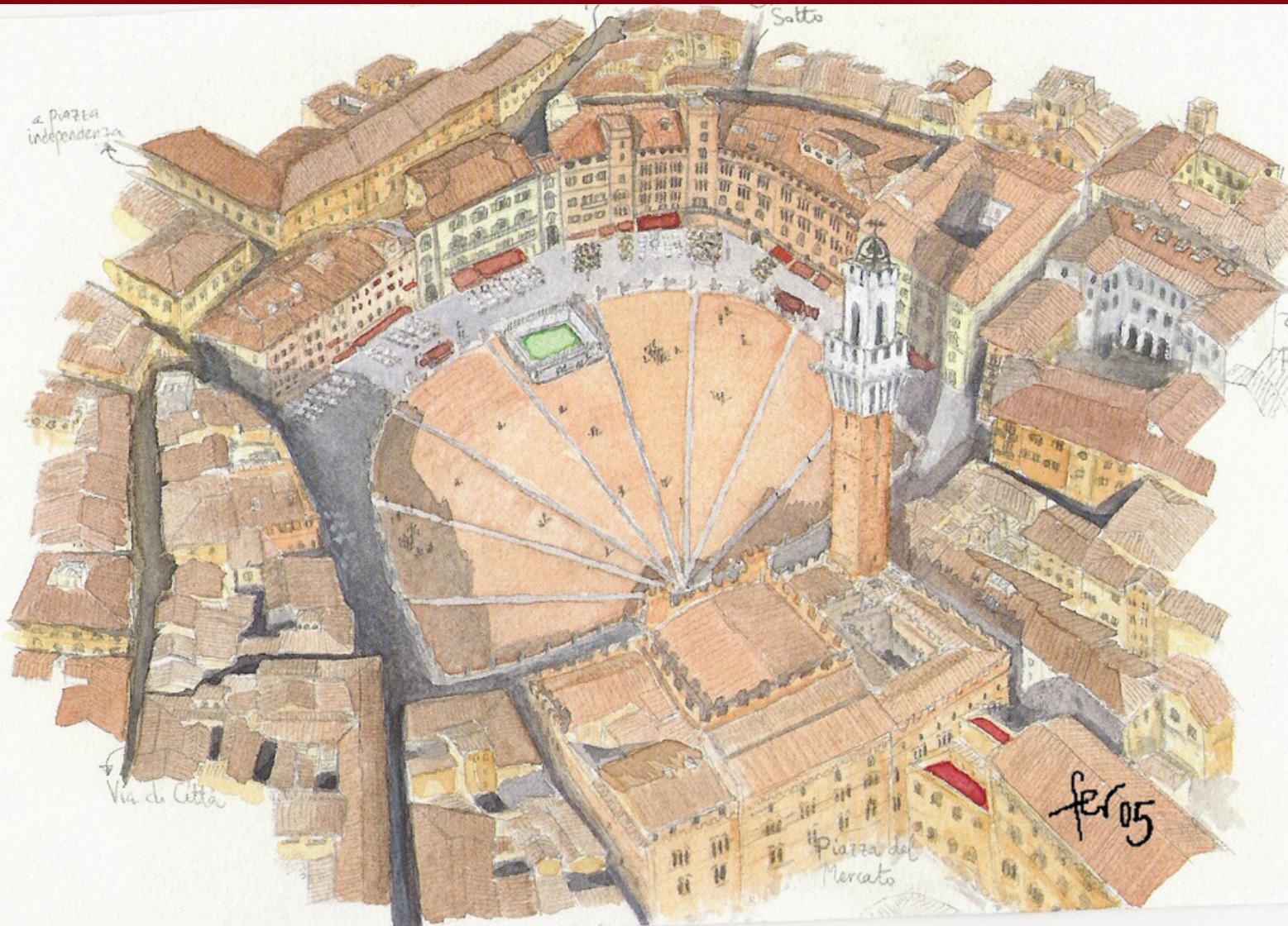
