Provisional Learning Agreement

Exchange students must complete a Learning Agreement with the list of courses they intend to take at the University of Siena. This agreement must be signed by:


- The student
- The responsible person at the sending university
- The responsible person at the receiving institution (University of Siena)



Quick tip!

The responsible person at the University of Siena is the academic Erasmus/Exchange coordinator (USiena Exchange Coordinator).

UniSi had 16,000 students in 2022, which was nearly one-third of Siena's total population of around 53,000. It is very important for students to follow all the deadlines as no exception can be made.

Submission Deadlines:

- First Semester Students: July 1st to September 15th, 2024
- Second Semester Students: December 1st, 2024 to February 15th, 2025.

Submitting the Learning Agreement

How to Send Your Learning Agreement:

- **European Students:** Fill out the Learning Agreement on the OLA platform and include the name and email address of the USiena Exchange Coordinator in the "Receiving Responsible Person" section.
- Non-European Students or European Students Not Enabled on the OLA
 Platform: Download the form <u>here</u> and email it as a PDF to the USiena Exchange Coordinator.

Final Learning Agreement

- First Semester Students:
- Submission Window: September 1st to September 30th.
- Modification Deadline: October 23rd, 2024.
- Second Semester Students:
- Submission Window: February 1st to March 7th.
- Modification Deadline: March 25th, 2025.



Instructions:

- Once your final Learning Agreement is signed by the USiena Exchange Coordinator, upload it <u>here</u>.
- If modifications are needed, update the "during the mobility" section and get it signed by all parties.
- Upload the modified agreement <u>here</u>.

Note: Students can attend classes even if the learning agreement hasn't been uploaded on segreteria online.




Quick tip!

Course Registration and ECTS Credits


Registering for Courses:

The Learning Agreement itself represents your registration for the chosen courses. You can attend all courses from the start of the semester.

Your study plan (libretto) will be uploaded into your "Segreteria Online" for exam registration (appelli).

Note: Students must register for exams on segreteria online even if they are already enrolled for course on moodle.

Students are also allowed to choose from multiple resits for the exams.



ECTS Credits:

•All study programs at USiena are measured in ECTS credits.

•1 ECTS credit equals 25 hours of workload.

•Full-time one-year study program: 60 credits (30 per semester).

Assessment and Grading System

Assessment:

•Credits are earned upon passing course assessments.

•Exams are mainly oral, with some written tests.

•Multiple exam dates are available.

•Students can retake exams if not satisfied with their grades, subject to specific rules.

Grading System:

•Scale: 0 to 30, with 18 as the passing mark.

•"Cum laude" (30 e lode) is a distinction for outstanding performance.
