INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADJUSTMENT OF MERIT RANGES

The student is required to know the maximum number of credits (CFU) possible for the current year of the course on which he/she is enrolled. This information is also available from the Student and Course Administration Office of the relevant Department.

The adjustment of the merit ranges is based on the relation $M:V=M1:V1$ and is calculated by the formula: $V1=(M1*V)/M$

where **M** is the maximum number of credits obtainable for the year of enrolment in courses with 60 credits/year (e.g. 60 in Year 1 to calculate the merit of Year 2, 120 at Year 2 to calculate the merit of Year 3, etc.)

M1 is the maximum number of credits obtainable for the year of enrolment in courses with credits different from 60 per year (e.g. 57 in Year 1 to calculate the merit of Year 2, 123 at Year 2 to calculate the merit of Year 3, etc.)

V is the value in the merit range table

V1 is the value in the adjusted merit range table.

N.B. All credits earned and the value of the adjusted range must be rounded off to the whole number immediately below.

Example: A student enrolled in Year 3 of a course (**considers the sum of the credits earned by 31st October, i.e. earned in previous years, i.e. Years 1 and 2**) expects to earn 110 credits instead of 120 credits (maximum number of credits that can be earned before enrolment in Year 3)

$M=120$, $M1=110$, $V=90$ (value in the merit range table, Year 3 "up to 90"), $V1=82$ (up to 82)

thus for the student, Table C of the Fee Regulations will have the following adjusted merit ranges:
